## **2008 Dutton Ranch Chardonnay**

### **92 Points - Wine Enthusiast**

“Beautiful and likeable for its dryness, crisp minerality, and the sleek, clean mouthfeel. The fruit suggests oak-inspired pears, oranges and citrons. This elegant quaff gets better as it warms in the glass.”

## **2008 Rued Vineyard Chardonnay**

“This vineyard has proven itself for so many years that it’s practically a guarantee of greatness. This 2008 is a real stunner. It’s so rich and exotic, so balanced and dry, so clean. Dazzles with pear, pineapple, lychee, roasted hazelnut, crème brulee, buttered toast, honey and spice flavors, wrapped into a creamy smooth mouthfeel. Brilliant and compelling.”

## **2008 Dutton Ranch Pinot Noir**

## **2008 Devil’s Gulch Vineyard Pinot Noir**

### **90 points – Wine Enthusiast**

Aromatically, the definitive wild blackberry jumps from the glass, surrounded by coriander spice and wild cherry overtones. In the mouth, the wild berry fruits prevail, supported by exceptionally rich tannins and bright acidity. Let this wine breath a bit and you will be rewarded with a wonderful combination of restrained power and silky indulgence.

## **2008 Freestone Hill Vineyard Pinot Noir**

### **95 points – Wine Enthusiast**

“Extraordinary for how drinkable it is right now, and for how it will evolve. Shows the crisp acidity and minerality of this cool-climate vineyard, with rich flavors of raspberries, cherry liqueur, cola, exotic spices, vanilla, buttered cinnamon toast and smoky sandalwood. Yet the tannic integrity should help it change in fascinating ways over the next six years.”

## **2008 Sanchiotti Vineyard Pinot Noir**

## **2008 Morelli Lane Vineyard Zinfandel**

“Crushed berries, orange zest and licorice on the nose, with complementary oak. A pure and penetrating style of zinfandel, with juicy flavors of blackberry and spices. Finishes firm but not hard, with a note of bitter chocolate and noteworthy persistence.”

## **2008 Cherry Ridge Vineyard Syrah**

### **New Release**

In the nose it’s black cherry, Asian spice, white pepper, and a hint of Sandalwood. There’s also a touch of leather which is so classic to the varietal. In the mouth, especially with a little breathing, the rich cherry and spice really coat your mouth, carried by lush sweet tannin structure. The acidity keeps the brightness in the wine, as well as promising a long future ahead.
